Public transportation:

The region has an integrated ticketing system and HSL tickets are valid on all buses, commuter trains and trams. HSL area is divided into four zones and ticket prices are based on the distance traveled. If you plan on using public transport, downloading the HSL app is recommended.

Helsinki area public transportation and Journey planner

Travel between Nokia offices at Karaportti and Helsinki-Vantaa Airport (HEL)

Taxi: Helsinki-Vantaa Airport is located around 20 km from the city centre and 22 km from Karaportti. Cost estimate to either location is approximately 45 EUR.


Travel to and from Helsinki-Vantaa airport

The airport taxis pick you up in front of terminal 1 and on ground floor at terminal 2. The following taxi agencies are serving the airport as its contractual partners:

<u>Lähitaksi</u> <u>Vantaan Taksi – Helsinki Airport Taxi</u> <u>Taksi Helsinki (Taksi helsinki App)</u>

Agency-specific price information is available in front of the terminals, on the information screens next to the taxi ranks. Other agencies may also provide their services to Helsinki Airport's passengers. Where the agency is not one of those specified above, the customer agrees on the price separately.

There are multiple bus connections operating from Helsinki city centre to Helsinki Airport around the clock. I and P trains serve the Ring Rail Line between the Airport and Helsinki city centre. The timetables, routes and ticket prices can be found on the <u>HSL website</u>. and <u>HSL app</u> Please notice that to travel from the Airport to Helsinki city centre, you will need a ticket to the **ABC** zone.


Travel between Nokia offices at Karaportti campus and Helsinki city centre

Taxi: Cost estimate approximately 35 EUR, travel time 20–30 min. More detailed cost estimations available at https://www.lahitaksi.fi/en

Train: Take E-train to the direction of "Kauklahti" or U-train to "Kirkkonummi" and step out at "Kera" railway station, walk to the right, distance to Nokia offices 800-1000 m. Travel time approximately 40 min.

Bus: take bus 235 or 218 from "Elielinaukio" close to the Railway Station. Buses stop at "Karanristi". Travel time approximately 50 min.

Traveling to Villa Koivusaari

The consortium meeting on **Thursday, Sep 26**, will take place at Villa Koivusaari. Telkkäkuja 11, 00200 Helsinki. Friday, Sep 27, will be an optional day For consortium members

Metro: Villa Koivusaari is situated 500 meters away from the Koivusaari Metro station. The travel time from Helsinki city centre takes about 6 minutes. A day ticket within transportation zone A can be purchased for 8€. A single ticket costs 2.80€.

Taxi: About 10 min from Helsinki city centre, 15–20 min from Karaportti Campus or 30 min from the airport . Parking available.
